



Wetlands Cruise and Vintage Motorcycle Display Event at the Ward Melville Heritage Organization, Stony Brook, NY. Sunday, July 27th 2014, Time: 10 am

- Meet at the Ward Melville Museum for a tour of the evolution of the motorcycle narrated by club member Gerry Duff at 10:00am. Reserved parking for the club, so bring your Classic Jaguar.
- After the museum you may leave your car & walk or we'll shuttle you over to the parking lot of the Stony Brook Boat Works Marina at 11:45 am. We must arrive at least 15 minutes before departure to board the boat. The cruise is "tide sensitive" so we must depart on time.
- **Boat Departure is at 12:15pm sharp! If you're late the boat will not wait for you!** We'll board the covered pontoon boat "Discovery" for a unique club only private 1-1/2 hour cruise through Stony Brook Harbor to the surrounding wetlands. A naturalist from Stony Brook University Marine Sciences Center will describe the wildlife, ecology, geology, flora and history on the tour. Be sure to bring your binoculars for close up views of the wild life of the wetlands and scenery.
Bottled water will be provided by the club on the boat, but no food or other beverages permitted. There is a limited rest room facility on board for emergencies. Please use the facility at the museum before boarding the boat.
- After the cruise we'll have a late lunch at Latitude 121 Coastal Grill restaurant in the Stony Brook Village near the Post Office. **Pay as you go. Prices range from \$10 to \$15.**
- After lunch you may want to walk about the quaint village and enjoy the fine boutique shops or return to the museum for that one last look.

Space is limited to 27 people, no last minute arrivals once we reach capacity.

 Drive all the way to the back to the Ward Melville Heritage Museum.
