

VANDERBILT CAR SHOW- JAGUAR CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Champion Class- Is the most demanding JCNA class. All entries will have their interiors, exteriors, engine compartments and boots judged for authenticity, condition and cleanliness.

Preservation- included in Champion Class. Is for un-restored or near original cars over 20 years old. You should have copy of vehicles Jaguar Heritage Certificate.

Driven Class- Is for Jaguars that regardless of age are in regular use.

In consideration of this usage cars in this class do not have their engine compartments or boots judged. However the exteriors and interiors are judged to the same standards as Champion Class.

Special Division Class- Is intended for factory and non-factory prepared competition and limited production Jaguars. The interior, exterior, engine compartment and boot are judged only for condition and cleanliness not for authenticity. Must present documented race history or racing logbook.

Display Class- Cars will not be judged. However they will be placed on the show field in the same general area as similar vehicles and will be eligible for Peoples Choice Awards.
